We encourage all teams across both SeaPerch and SeaGlide programs to pursue the optional “Make a Splash” community outreach project. An award will be given to a single team in the Greater Philadelphia SeaPerch and SeaGlide Challenge that demonstrates making a positive impact in their community. This portion of the competition is optional, but recommended.

This award will be given to the team that best represents positive change to make a difference in their community and acts as a model for other teams, and all of us, to bring positivity to one another by “making a splash”.

We want to highlight YOUR contributions and bring some positivity to the local community. These submissions are open ended. They could be a story, a news article, a video, or a something else that describes how your team has made a positive impact in the community this season. Your efforts will be highlighted during the Greater Philadelphia SeaPerch and SeaGlide Challenge and we will announce a winner during the event award ceremony.

We ask teams to submit their “Make a Splash” project to [nswcpdstem@gmail.com](mailto:nswcpdstem@gmail.com) by March 22, 2023 for consideration. Please identify your school or organization by writing “Make a Splash Submission [Your School or Organization Name]” in the subject line of the email submission.

Submissions are not limited by program or team. For example, if your school or organization competes in both SeaPerch and SeaGlide, you can submit one “Make a Splash” project for your entire school or organization. You could also have multiple teams from multiple schools or organizations who collaborate to make a bigger community impact (just include the name of all schools and organizations involved).
